

INDIANA STATE HIGH POWER 100 YARD REDUCED COURSE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH 2017

HOSTEDED BY: FALL CREEK VALLEY CONSERVATION CLUB

WHERE: 1204 EAST GILMORE ROAD. FROM I-69 EXIT 26, 3 MILES SOUTH ON SR 109 TO GILMORE ROAD. TURN RIGHT, CLUB IS ½ MILE ON RIGHT.

WHEN: AUGUST 19, 2017, SATURDAY
REGISTRATION 11:30AM – 12:30PM
RELAY # 1 1:00 PM, RELAY # 2 AFTER RELAY #1

ELIGIBILITY: All competitors are encouraged to be members of the National Rifle Association. Membership in the Indiana State Rifle and Pistol Association or the State Association of the State in which the competitor resides is strongly encouraged. Liability waivers for Fall Creek Valley Conservation Club must be signed by all shooters and personnel before the Match.

COURSE OF FIRE:

80 RD. MATCHES AT 100 YARDS

SIGHTERS: A 10 Minute sighting period prior to stage 1.
No other sighting shots will be allowed.

MATCHES:

1. 20RDS. STANDING 20 MIN. SR-1 TARGET
2. 20RDS. SITTING RPD. 60 SEC. SR-1 TARGET, 2 STRINGS
3. 20 RDS. PRONE RPD. 70 SEC. SR-21 TARGET, 2 STRINGS
4. 20 RDS. PRONE 20 MIN. MR-31 TARGET

RULES: NRA HIGH POWER RULES WILL APPLY
EAR PROTECTION, EYE PROTECTION, EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI)
REQUIRED.

CLASSIFICATION:

The NRA Classification system will be used for the match. Anyone who does not have a High Power classification will fire in the Master Class (Master Unclassified) for one match only. A temporary score book will be maintained and future entries based on scores fired, see Rule 19.6 or 19.2.

ENTRY FEE: ADULTS \$35.00
JUNIORS \$25.00

CHANGES IN SCHEDULE:

The Match Director reserves the right to alter any facet of the match. All changes will be posted and/or announced on the firing line. **This match will be fired Rain or Shine** on the date scheduled. Relay start times may have to be determined by the Match Director.

RIFLES: Rifles will be classified per the NRA Rule book. There must be a minimum of five (5) shooters to make a separate class.

AMMUNITION:

Any safe ammunition allowed. No tracer or incendiary ammo allowed. No ammunition will be furnished for the match.

SCORING: Scoring will be done by competitors.

AWARDS: Awards will be given to Match Winner, First in Class (5 to 9 shooters), Second in Class (10 to 15 shooters), First Match Rifle, First Service Rifle, First Any Sight Tactical. Competitor must be a member of the NRA to set an NRA National Record.

ADDITIONAL MATCH AWARDS:

Perpetual Trophies for the Match Winner of the State Championship 100 Yard Reduced Course Match is maintained by the Indiana State Rifle and Pistol Association. Trophies are updated annually after the conclusion of the State Championship Series and Awards are presented at the ISRPA Annual Awards Banquet in November. A framed representation of the updated trophy is presented to the winner which is theirs to keep.

FACILITIES: 15 firing points, covered firing line, Rest rooms.
